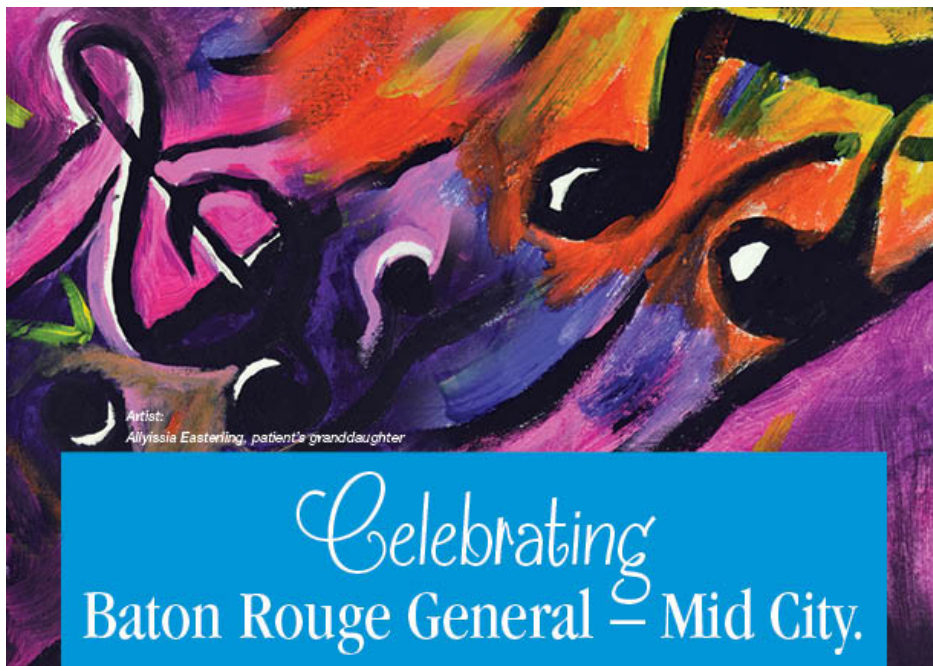




Baton Rouge General

Focused on post-acute care and behavioral health issues, the campus has thrived over the past year, adding new services and tenants that include telemedicine, home health care, and the health innovation center. Last month, the Family Health Center expanded its offices and moved into the Medical Office Building, which is now nearing capacity. And in October, HAART (HIV AIDS Alliance for Region Two) will move into its new office on campus. **With more than 800 employees and nearly 25 services offered, the Mid City campus also played a key role in flood recovery** – serving as a special needs shelter before the state shelter was opened and acting as temporary living quarters for more than 50 Baton Rouge General employees and their families.
