Mid City Redevelopment Alliance (MCRA) will host the 7th Annual Legacy Luncheon on Thursday, August 12th honoring Hermann "Buck" Moyses III at Boudreaux's, 2647 Government Street. MCRA is honoring Mr. Moyses for his commitment to the Mid City region as the first chairman of the organization's board of directors and for his consistent support of MCRA over the years.

MCRA also recognizes Mr. Moyses for his lifetime service to other non-profit organizations in Baton Rouge, including Baton Rouge Crisis Intervention Center, Baton Rouge Speech and Hearing Foundation, Louisiana Nature Conservancy, Capital Area Corporate Recycling Foundation, Louisiana Art and Science Museum, Crime Stoppers of Baton Rouge and Arts Council of Greater Baton Rouge.

Charles Smith, George Jenne, Thomas Sawyer and Baton Rouge General Medical Center, and Pastor Raymond Jetson.
